

## Life of Eleanor Walker (Hughes Williams)

1860	Born in King's Lynn, 25 <sup>th</sup> June in East Street, Albert Street
1861	Living in Heacham Road, Heacham, Norfolk
1871	Living with grandmother Eleanor Nelson as an inmate in Smith's almshouse, 6 St. James's Road, St. Margarets', (illegible – Middle?), King's Lynn
1878	Marries Owen Hughes August 24 <sup>th</sup> in Hull, a mariner
1881	Lives in 71 New Street, Ynyscynhaiarn, Caernarvonshire (registration district: Tremadoc, Ffestiniog) with brothers William and Thomas
before 1891	marries Patrick Williams
1891	living with Patrick Williams, 72 Low Friar Street, St. Johns, Newcastle
1891 to 1893	move to Hull
1893	Daughter Rose born in Hull
1894	Son Frank born in Hull
1894 to 1896	move to 35 Cope Street, Ladywood, Birmingham
1896	Daughter Mabel born in Birmingham
1898	Daughter Elsie born in Birmingham
1899	Son Tom born in Birmingham
1899 to 1901	move to Wootton Wawen
1901	living in Grange Cottage, Wootton Wawen 30 <sup>th</sup> June widowed
1902	according to Margery moved to St Chad's School Birmingham on death of Patrick

death – according to Margery around 1919. Checked all death registers from 1918 to 1921 – no Eleanor Williams recorded in Birmingham, however 1919 Q4 is missing.

1891	living with Eleanor Williams 72 Low Friar Street, St. Johns, Newcastle
1891 to 1893	move to Hull
1893	Daughter Rose born in Hull
1894	Son Frank born in Hull
1895 to 1896	move to 35 Cope Street, Ladywood, Birmingham
1896	Daughter Mabel born in Birmingham
1898	Daughter Elsie born in Birmingham
1899	Son Tom born in Birmingham
1899 to 1901	move to Wootton Wawen; becomes mercantile (seas) marine engineer
1901	living in Grange Cottage, Wootton Wawen dies 30 <sup>th</sup> June of ?? (illegible)
